
I Will Build My Church

Electoral Roll

The electoral roll is a crucial document which represents the formal membership of our church community – basically for everyone who considers SCC to be their home church, as part of the wider Church of England. The roll enables members to vote and participate in church governance. Additionally, it serves as the basis for our church directory, helping to maintain accurate contact information for all members.

This year, this is a brand new list and so everyone who wishes to be on the roll (and is eligible) has to complete a Form 3 (located on the Welcome Desk) by 28th March 2025.

To be eligible you must be over 16 and baptised, and either be resident within Ashford Town Parish or have been a regular attendee of SCC for more than 6 months.

Please do all sign up if you can.

Baptism by Full Immersion Sunday 1st June 2025

For anyone who has come to believe and trust in Christ, baptism is a public expression of an inner conviction to live for Him. Baptism is a Biblical command and we look forward to baptising adults, young people and children on our Baptism Sunday in June. For others, you may wish to Renew your Baptismal Vows if made a long time ago or by your parents on your behalf. Please speak with Rev Jo for further detail.

Deanery Confirmation Service Saturday 14th June 2025

Confirmation in the Church of England is for adults and young people who have been baptised as babies, who wish to 'confirm' their own faith in Jesus Christ as their personal Lord and Saviour in a formal Anglican service. Do chat with Rev Jo for more information and sign up for the preparation sessions coming soon.
